3. *Create a roles and responsibilities chart for a given nonprofit situation (optional exercise, depending upon time).*
4. *Expand on the milestones, deliverables, and schedule in the charter that was part of the larger project plan.*
5. *Develop a Risk Impact chart.*
6. *Complete a short Lessons Learned Report for the project you identified in Exercise 1.*

Classes are recognized by the international Project Management Institute Education Foundation (PMIEF) and taught locally by credentialed Project Management Professionals (PMPs).
