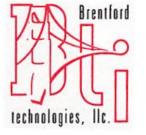

Available Platforms = Client (PC) / Server / Cloud (On-Line - 2013)

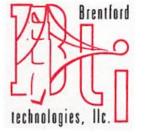




PC Scheduling Tools - MS Project

 - Do you get both a consistency and transparency in reporting

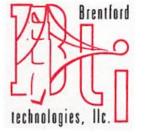
Answer = Schedule Template(s)





Microsoft Project

- How?
 - Develop schedule templates that reflect the different types of work the organization performs.
 - Lite, medium, heavy (traditional) and Sprint
 - Establish the gate / phase sign-off
 - Dynamic scheduling techniques applied
 - Source for Score Card reporting no exceptions
 - Source for Resource management / Over-allocation
 - Baseline Reporting
 - Critical Path analysis
